The discussion about this point need more time; however the following points have been summarized.

The residual budget will be allocated for activities beneficial for Tunisian Universities.

Estimated residual budget from canceled meetings: Milan (€ 48,325); Meeting in Paris (€ 16,470)

Possible use of residual budget: European accreditation of the Master in NPR, scholarships for the students, individual visits of tunisian staff in EU to meet stakeholder, allow more staff to participate to the remaining training session

Considerations: possibility to ask the Project officer for multiple use of residual budget according to the needs of Tunisian partners
